Note that as per paragraph 25, a high growth LGA is defined as an LGA in the top 10% of LGAs experiencing growth in a 1-, 3- and/or 5-year period. The ABS Regional Population Statistics dataset is used when determining high growth LGAs.

Note the Department has identified the process used to calculate the top 10% of LGAs experiencing growth in 2025 used percentages rounded to 1 decimal place, which led to the inclusion of 2 additional LGAs: Georges River and Lockhart. Given the marginal differences in percentage growth, the department will retain these LGAs for the usual eligibility period.
