- teacher demonstration only, for activities in category 4
- student participation for collection, observation and release of tadpoles (frogs)
- student participation with the five nominated species of native animals.

For student participation in category 4/5, teacher demonstration of category 5, or any other activities using animals, written approval, in advance from the SACEC, is required.

The above activities must be described in the school's teaching programs.
